Euler Scholarship

Established by Mrs. Euler's will, the fund is to be used to provide scholarship assistance to full-time students to prepare for the ministry (Masters of Divinity and/or Christian Education) at official accredited seminaries of the Presbyterian Church (USA). Applications, which are available on the Synod's website or by calling the Synod Office, are due February 1st each year. Scholarships are renewable annually based on academic achievement and financial need.

Visionary

Established with the proceeds from the sale of a building on Alexander Avenue in Durham, North Carolina to be used by to develop new, existing, racially inclusive and creative programs which address ways to implement the priorities of the Synod in the areas of education, evangelism, and social justice.

Peacemaking

Receives and distributes the Synod's portion of the Peacemaking Offering through a grant process coordinated by the Grants & Awards Committee. Applications may be found on the Synod website.

Small Church Grants

Distributes income from the McCallum and Small Church and Manse funds to new and small churches for home mission projects and assistance for renovation of church facilities and manses.
